<b><i>NURSERY YEAR 1</i></b>	Face to face classes	Rotation	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>CLASSES WILL BEGIN ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> JANUARY 2022.</b></li> <li>The school will inform parents when each group of students should attend.</li> <li>Schools will use a rotation or shift system <b>ONLY</b> if all students <b>CANNOT</b> be accommodated in accordance with social distancing guidelines.</li> <li>The shift system must only be used for Grade A schools (large schools).</li> <li>Most nursery students will be taught for 4 hours per day. The amount of time will be determined by each school. Schools using the shift system may teach each group of learners for less than 4 hours per day.</li> </ol>

<b><i>GRADE 1</i></b>	Face to face classes or online classes	Rotation, if face to face classes are kept	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>CLASSES WILL BEGIN ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> JANUARY 2022.</b></li> <li>If all students can be accommodated in a school in accordance with social distancing guidelines, then all students can attend, every day.</li> <li>Schools will use a rotation system <b>ONLY</b> if all students <b>CANNOT</b> be accommodated in accordance with social distancing guidelines.</li> <li>Large schools may rotate the Grade 6 to facilitate the attendance of Grade 5 students.</li> <li>Grade 6 must be given preference to attend face to face classes; followed by Grade 5 and then the other classes.</li> </ol>

<b><i>GRADE 3</i></b>	Face to face classes or online classes	Rotation, if face to face classes are kept

<b><i>GRADE 5</i></b>	Face to face classes or online classes	Rotation, if face to face classes are kept	
<b><i>GRADE 6</i></b>	Face to face classes	Everyday	
<b><i>GRADE 7</i></b>	<i>Face to face classes or online classes</i>	<i>Rotation, if face to face classes are kept</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b><i>CLASSES WILL BEGIN ON THE 10<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2022.</i></b></li> <li><b><i>If there is space for students to be accommodated</i></b> in accordance with social distancing guidelines, <b><i>then classes can be held every day for everyone.</i></b></li> <li><b><i>If there isn't space for students to be accommodated</i></b> in accordance with social distancing guidelines, <b><i>then classes can be held on rotation.</i></b></li> <li><b><i>Online classes may be held solely or in conjunction with the rotation of face to face classes</i></b></li> </ol>
<b><i>GRADE 8</i></b>	Face to face classes only	Everyday	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>CLASSES WILL BEGIN ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> JANUARY 2022.</b></li> <li>ONLY face to face classes will be offered.</li> <li>Face to face classes will be held every day for everyone. There will be no rotation.</li> </ol>
