Instructions: Let us make a pizza and divide it into quarters.

Materials:

- paper plate
- brown paint
- yellow paint or yellow paper
- scissors
- paint brush
- pizza topping coloring page



Steps:

- First, paint or colour the rim of a clean paper plate brown to look like a pizza crust.
- Once the brown paint is dry, paint/ colour the rest of the plate yellow, or cut out a circle of yellow paper and glue it to the middle.
- Next, you can color the pizza topping from the colouring page that is provided.
- Now, glue the pizza topping onto the yellow paint/cut out paper (or cheese). If you have used paint, all your paint should be dry before this step. You can talk to your child about "whole", "halves" and "quarters" by helping them cut the pizza into 2 equal sections (half) then 4 equal sections (quarters)
