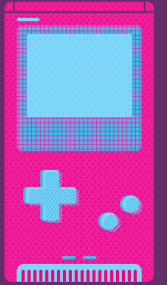
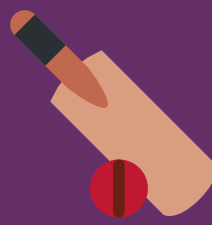
## TIPS FOR PARENTS WITH YOUNG CHILDREN LEARNING AT HOME

1



Prepare for the session by ensuring that your child is relaxed and that you have all the things you need for the lesson (pencils, crayons and worksheets, etc.) Check worksheet instructions for added resources.

2



Remove any distractions from the learning space.

3



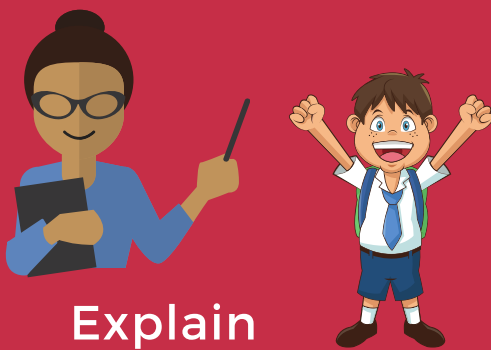
Remember, the learning space can be anywhere, at the kitchen table, under the house, on the steps, under a tree, anywhere. Make sure your child is physically comfortable and ready to learn.

4



Read the instructions for the activities slowly with your child.

5



Explain the instructions to your child.

6



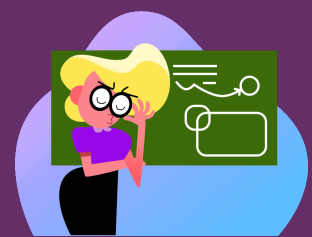
Ask your child to say what the task is, in his/her own words.

7



Encourage your child to complete one task at a time in the order given in the instruction.

8



If during the activity you and, or your child become frustrated, take a break and try the activity again later.

9
