Physical features help to form our lands.


Description of physical features of the communities.

Physical feature	Description
Island	A piece of land completely surrounded by water
Valley	A low area between hills and mountains often where a river flows
Beach	Gently sloping shore next to a body of water washing by waves or roots often

Mountain	An area that is at least 500 meters higher than the land around it
Lake	A large body of water surrounded by land
