Sub-topic: Present tense of irregular Verbs

Objective: With the aid of a reading passage based on verb forms, students will

- Fluently read a passage in the target language
- Correctly answer questions based on same.
- Correctly complete a worksheet based on AR regular verbs
- Orally identify verbs with irregular YO forms
- Correctly complete a worksheet based on irregular verb forms

Concept: To understand the importance of first form irregular verbs in the present tense

Content:

### **Irregular Spanish verbs in the Present Tense**

Spanish irregular present tense verbs fall into various categories: verbs with irregular yo forms in the present tense, stem-changing verbs, spelling-change verbs, and verbs that are irregular in all forms.

### **Verbs with Irregular Yo Forms**

The following verbs have irregular yo forms. **The other present tense forms of these verbs follow the patterns for regular -ar, -er, and -ir verbs.**

Here are examples of verbs with irregular YO spelling changes.

SPANISH INFINITIVE	ENGLISH INFINITIVE	YO FORM
caer	to fall	caigo
conocer	to know	conozco
dar	to give	doy
hacer	to do/make	hago
poner	to put	pongo
saber	to know	sé
salir	to leave/to go out	salgo
traducir	to translate	traduzco
traer	to bring	traigo
